Dear Neighbour

As you may already know, the Lyngford Park Surgery is shortly due to be extended to provide additional clinical rooms and administrative space for our growing workforce and patient list size.

This extension is long-awaited and is essential to the future provision of NHS GP services to our local residents. While the range of our services and patient list size have increased over the last few years, our building size has not.

The building contractor is scheduled to start work on the Lyngford Park Surgery site from March/April and it is expected that work will continue into the early part of 2022 – throughout this time the work of the Surgery will continue to provide services as normal.

We have emphasized to the building contractor that there should be as little noise, disruption and mess around the Surgery and its neighbouring area as possible during this period. However, we are aware that there will be times when some inconvenience will be caused, and we apologise for this in advance. We would ask for your patience during this period and hope that you will be able to benefit from the improvements when the surgery extension is completed.
